Lorraine Williams – Vocals

Singer Lorraine Williams performs with top Bay Area stage productions and has tremendous present and vocal capabilities. Her recent performance credits include singing with the Bay Area's own tribute to Sting and The Police: "Stung" at Slims and Bimbo's night clubs in San Francisco. Lorraine has shared the stage with recording artists and Bay Area rockers Rubber Side Down, Gilby Clarke and George Lynch. Including special performances at the SF Pride concert main stage SF Civic Center, and the ATT Stadium Park. Her recent engagements with Broadway style musical productions continues to add to Ms. Williams growing popularity as a singer and performer. When not performing Lorraine leads Rhythm Lounge Studios in Lafayette CA as principle, and instructor for rock vocals and piano.

Rich Montero - Guitar

Rich is a long time Bay Area guitar player who has performed with local indie and cover bands. Rich began his formal music training through a student of Andres Segovia, and was inspired by the Spanish and Classical guitar-master Charles Ferguson. Rich continued exploring jazz, and big-band swing music under the direction of Bay Area jazz icon David Hardiman. Rich has led a number of rock, pop, and fusion song writing groups, and has performed throughout the Bay Area, Seattle, and internationally through USO sponsored tour groups.

In 2005 Rich released a self-produced record of original songs. Now in his 4th year of playing Led Zeppelin music, the nuance and details of the powerful riff master Jimmy Page drives his daily practice and performances. Adam Briere - Drums

When drummer prodigy Adam Briere is not performing with his rock bands he tours with his jazz ensemble. Adam grew up inspired by his idol John Bonham, learning and playing the rhythms needed to power a Led Zeppelin band.
